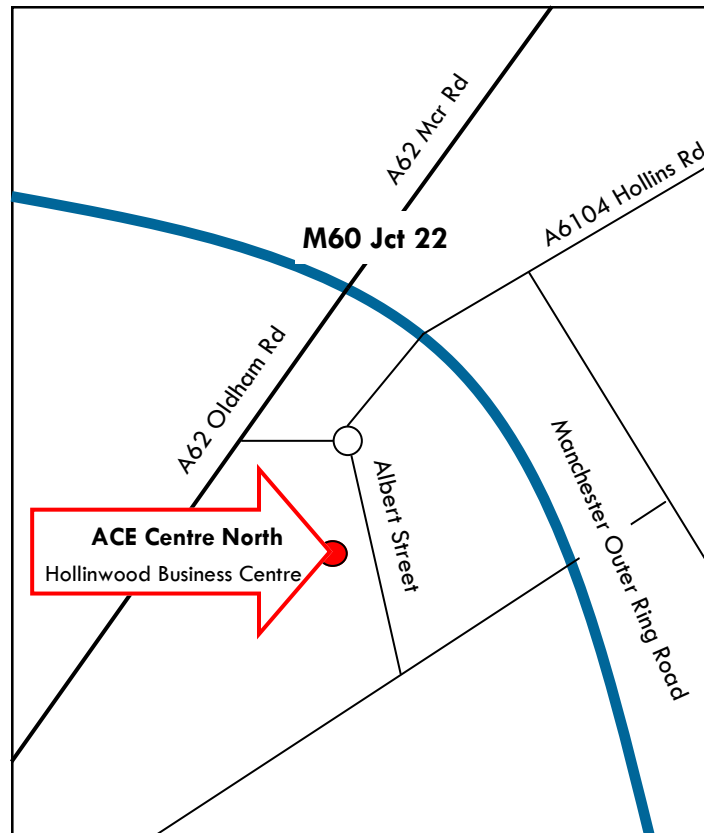


From Junction 22 on M60 take A62 Oldham Rd towards Manchester
